We are gearing up for another great Mid-State Classic Rodeo at the **Paso Robles Event Center**. This rodeo will present **saddles** to the all-around cowboy and cowgirl, **buckles** to reserve all-around, **buckles** to each event winner, **prizes** to reserve event winners, **buckles** to rookie all-around boy and girl, and **jackpot money** paid on each go. Event winners are based on the average and All-Around Awards are based on total points. In case of all-around award tie, winner will be decided based on money won. Both arenas are covered, so the rodeo will take place rain or shine.

This is a sanctioned rodeo (points count for your district) for districts 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 for ALL EVENTS and District 3 and 5 for Reined Cow Horse, however any member of NHSRA is invited to compete for jackpot money and prizes.

All entry fees include a \$10 jackpot fee for each event entered. Jackpot will be paid on each go.

*****Note Check In times*****

Cutters Check in: Thursday 6:00pm to 9:00 pm and Friday 7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. Cutting will start at 8:00 a.m. 2nd Round of Cutting will follow completion of Round 1 of Cutting.

Reined Cow Horse: RCH will run Saturday evening.

Rough Stock Check In: Friday, 11am to 1:00 p.m., Cal Poly Rough Stock Clinic 2:00 p.m., 1st Round of Rough Stock will be @ 5 pm Friday, 2nd Round of Rough Stock will be after Team Roping 1st go Saturday.

Goat Tying Check In: Friday, 11am to 1 p.m., Both Go's of Goat Tying will run Friday beginning at 3:00 p.m. (Tie Down Goats @ 1:00pm)

Goat tying 1st Go will begin following the completion of Mixed cutting, not to begin BEFORE 3:00pm

All Others: Check in: Friday 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. 7:00-9:00 pm & Saturday 6:00 a.m. to 6:45 a.m. If you are not in line at 6:45 a.m. you will be turned out of the rodeo.

Mandatory Ground Rules Meeting will be immediately following check in Saturday at 6:45 a.m. Rodeo begins following ground rules on Saturday. Grand Entry will be at 7:45 am

All Trailers will be parked in designated area. Parking violations will be towed at owner's expense. Private motorized ATV's, scooters etc. are allowed on the grounds.
