GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION FOR THE NEALER PRYOR SCHOLARSHIP

Follow all instructions in the scholarship packet and on the application.

You must be a member in good standing.

The scholarship will be held in trust by CHSRA District 7 Scholarship Committee for two years and will be paid out on proof of enrollment. You can use the money for tuition and education-related expenses. You need to submit your expense receipts to the designated District 7 person or persons in charge of the distribution of scholarship funds.

If you leave school and don't return during the two years after graduation, all unused funds from the awarded scholarship will return back into the district 7 Nealer Pryor Scholarship fund to be used for future scholarships.

No scholarship funds will be sent until a copy of proof of enrollment is received.

Once the D7 scholarship application forms are received, all applicants go through an interview process before the chosen District 7 Scholarship panel.

Scholarship awards will be announced during the District 7 Awards Banquet.
